JOB DESCRIPTION

Associate Degree Nursing Instructor Skills and Computer Laboratories

GENERAL STATEMENT OF FUNCTION: Performs as an instructor in nursing education to meet the needs of students in accordance with the purpose, philosophy, and objectives established by Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College and the Associate Degree Nursing Division. Responsible for the coordination, scheduling, assisting, and monitoring of skills and computer laboratories inventory. Responsible for instruction, evaluation and student use pertaining to both the Skills Laboratory and Computer Laboratory. The nursing instructor is responsible to the Campus ADN Department Chairperson for administering the duties and responsibilities of an ADN faculty member.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Establish and uphold a climate conducive to learning.
2. Be a professional and academic role model.
3. Be a positive team player on the ADN faculty team.
4. Value and respect each ADN student and faculty member.
5. Facilitate learning and serve as a resource person.
6. Supervise patient care administered by students including, but not limited to, all medication administration, treatments, and plans of care in the simulation laboratory or clinical area.
7. Evaluate student performance and progress.
8. Counsel ADN students regarding academic and clinical performance.
9. Maintain appropriate records.
10. Comply with the policies of the Mississippi Board of Nursing, health care agencies, the College, and the ADN Department.
11. Follow the proper chain of command.
12. Participate with other faculty members in extra-curricular student activities.
13. Serve as a student advisor regarding academic matters.
14. Use technology to enhance instruction.
15. Maintain theory and clinical competence in assigned areas of teaching responsibility.
16. Facilitate Skills and Computer Laboratory experiences for the Associate Degree Nursing Program, as scheduled by the ADN Department Chairperson.

SPECIFIC CURRICULUM DUTIES:

1. Plan and develop the curriculum for presentation to the students.
2. Use multi-media instructional techniques, including facilitation of in-depth simulation training in order to fully utilize manikins for quality clinical experiences.
3. Assist students to master the course content.
4. Improve instruction methods, content, and value of each course taught.
5. Integrate subject content with clinical experiences.
6. Evaluate the curriculum.
7. Coordinate rotations for clinical experiences.
8. Supervise clinical experiences on weekdays and/or weekends, days and/or evenings as assigned.
9. Provide instruction in the classroom, skills and computer labs, and clinical as assigned.
