

MAJOR FEEDER HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE FOLLOW-UP FALL 2005

The Major Feeder High School Survey results for fall 2005 indicated that 3,405 students graduated from the 18 high schools in the MGCCC District in 2005. This represents an increase of 30 graduates (0.9%) compared with 2004.

The largest number (1,652) of high school graduates in 2005 was in Harrison County. This represents a decrease of 21 graduates (-1.2%) compared with last year. The second largest number (1,436) graduated from high schools in Jackson County; this represents an increase of 25 graduates (1.8%) above last year. The number of graduates in George County increased by ten (5.7%), while the number of graduates in Stone County decreased by five (-3.6%). The total number of graduates district-wide in 2005 was the second-highest in the past decade. Table 1 provides a ten-year summary of the number of high school graduates by county.

Table 2 shows the percent of graduates of each district high school that attended MGCCC in the fall or summer following graduation for each of the past five years. Of the 3,405 graduates this year, 1,570 (46%) enrolled at MGCCC during summer session or *prior to Hurricane Katrina* in fall semester, 2005. This represents the highest “market share” for recent high school graduates in the past ten years. Again, the fall semester enrollment records used in this report represent “pre-Katrina” enrollment, and this report illustrates another aspect of the impact that the hurricane had on Mississippi gulf Coast Community College.

Among the 18 high schools, the highest percentage of high school graduates that enrolled at MGCCC in fall 2005 was from Stone High School (67%). MGCCC enrolled more than 50% of the graduates of East Central (54%), Resurrection (52%), Long Beach (52%), and D’Iberville (51%) high schools. Other “high market share” high schools included George County (49%), Gautier (49%), St. Martin (49%), Vancleave (48%), and Moss Point (48%) high schools. The lowest percentages of recent graduates who enrolled at MGCCC were from Gulfport (39%) and Ocean Springs (39%) high schools.

Table 3 shows the number of graduates from each district high school that enrolled at each MGCCC campus/center. This table also shows the estimated percentage and number of graduates who attended college. Approximately 74% of all high school graduates in the district were reported by their high schools as "college-bound." MGCCC enrolled 62% of college-bound high school graduates in its district, an increase of two percentage points over last year.

Table 4 shows the number and percent of graduates from each district high school that enrolled at each of the three campuses (Perkinston, Jefferson Davis, and Jackson County) for the past decade.
