NURSE ENTRANCE TEST (NET) GUIDELINES

IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE NURSE ENTRANCE TEST, CONTACT THE ADN DEPT ON YOUR CAMPUS.

1. The NET provides profiles in the following areas: math skills, reading comprehension and rate, learning styles, social interaction, stress level, and test taking skills.
2. Applicants to the ADN Program are required to score 69 on the Math section and 59 on the Reading Comprehension section of the NET for admission to the ADN Program.
3. You must apply and be accepted to Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College before applying to take the NET.
4. See the attached Flow Chart for a diagram of instructions regarding the NET.
5. Go to the Learning Lab to review for the NET test.
6. Complete the Registration Form below and go to the Business Office and pay the \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee for the NET test. Keep the receipt to show proof of payment.
7. To schedule your NET test, **contact the Assessment Center via e-mail.**
8. At your scheduled testing time, bring a picture ID to the **Assessment Center**. No other items will be allowed in the Assessment Center.
9. The NET is administered by computer. Each section is timed. Maximum time for the test is 2 ½ hours.
10. Test results, along with a handout explaining how to interpret your Math and Reading test results, will be given to you approximately 30 minutes after the close of the testing period. The **testing staff will not discuss the results with you.** Contact a counselor or advisor if further explanation of your test results is needed. **Keep your copy of your test results for future use.**
11. Applicants who do not achieve the required minimum scores on the math and/or reading sections of the NET may retest as soon as they successfully complete designated remediation through their campus Learning Lab. Without remediation, applicants can retest only once every twelve months. Applicants must retest within 30 days of successful completion of remediation.
12. Applicants desiring to remediate should contact their campus Learning Lab to schedule remediation.
13. After successful remediation, contact the campus **Assessment Center** for a test time.
14. The highest Math score or Reading Comprehension score achieved on any testing will be applied toward meeting the admission requirement.
15. Students who are unsuccessful on the NET two times have the option to retest by paper and pencil rather than computer.
16. Once both the Math and Reading Comprehension sections of the NET are passed, contact the Admissions Office to request an appointment with the Director of Admissions or designee to begin the application process.
